

Turkey to impose holiday curfew on Dec. 31-early
Jan. 4

As a measure to stem the spread of COVID-19, Turkey will have a nationwide curfew spanning the traditional New Year's holiday, from Dec. 31 to early Jan. 4, the president announced on Monday. In addition to ongoing public health measures, the holiday lockdown will last from 9



p.m. on Dec. 31 to 5 a.m. on Jan. 4, Recep Tayyip Erdogan told reporters after a Cabinet meeting in the capital Ankara.

"We have started to see the positive effects of the restrictions and other measures," he said, stating this was thanks to the "public sacrifice."

AI-Assisted Cough Tracking Could Help Detect the Next Pandemic

AI-Assisted Cough Tracking Could Help Detect the Next Pandemic When Joe Brew worked for the Florida Department of Health as an epidemiologist for two years starting in 2013, he helped with syndromic surveillance, meaning he had the arduous job of reviewing the symptoms of patients coming into the emergency departments from all across the state. The goal of such work: to detect an abnormal spike of symptoms in an area that may indicate there's a public health concern. led Brew to turn to a device that billions have in their pockets—a smartphone—to provide public health authorities with real-time symptomatic data from the community. Brew and several colleagues founded Hyfe, a free phone application that uses artificial intelligence to detect and track users' coughs, a hallmark of many respiratory conditions including COVID-19.





Coronavirus Vaccine Tracker

Vaccines typically require years of research and testing before reaching the clinic, but in 2020, scientists embarked on a race to produce safe and effective coronavirus vaccines in record time. Researchers are currently testing 63 vaccines in clinical trials on humans, and 18 have reached the final stages of testing. At least 85 preclinical vaccines are under active investigation in animals.

How much faster is it spreading? It was first detected in September. In November around a quarter of cases in London were the new variant. This reached nearly two-thirds of cases in mid-

December. Mathematicians have been running the numbers on the spread of different variants in an attempt to calculate how much of an edge this one might have.

SpaceX Rocket Explodes During Cape Canaveral Test

In 2017, we saw a bitcoin bubble. In 2021, I expect we will see another. But, unlike the last, the alternative financial system has grown tremendously. We're beginning to see real, parallel economic activity outside of trading, commerce and credit facilities," Luongo said. "This growth represents real adoption, and it won't disappear when the next bubble bursts. "The value of one bitcoin hit \$20,000 on Wednesday, after a two-month climb that saw the cryptocurrency's value double, marking the first — some say second — time in history it has reached the all-time high.

The US government says there were no aliens and the crashed craft was a weather balloon. Others claim to have seen UFOs above or near the site, while some say they have been abducted by aliens, and even experimented on, before being returned to Earth.

The film crew decided to make an agreement with a special effects company to produce one of the most ambitious works in the history of cinema. Paul Walker, who died in a car accident in 2013, mourned his fans. Walker's death shelved the Fast and Furious 7 project, which was then being filmed, for a while. While everyone thought the movie would be canceled, the team made a deal with Paul's brothers, Cody and Caleb Walker. Both siblings would play the role of their brother. Of course, it was the task of an expert special effects company to make them look like Paul Walker.

US cyber-attack: US energy department confirms it was hit by Sunburst hack

Hackers are known to have at least monitored data within a range of key US government departments including state, defence, homeland security, treasury and commerce, Reuters news agency reports. Cisa said the perpetrators managed to breach computer networks using network management software made by the Texas-based IT company SolarWinds. Up to 18,000 SolarWinds Orion customers downloaded updates containing malicious software installed by hackers. All US federal civilian agencies were told to remove SolarWinds from their servers earlier this week as a result. Microsoft said it had identified more than 40 of its customers who were targeted in the cyber-attack, including government agencies, think tanks, non-governmental organisations and IT companies.

MH370: Malaysian plane lost 5 years ago and still unknown fate

It has been exactly 5 years since the flight number MH370 of Malaysian Airlines passenger plane disappeared in the Indian Ocean. The fate of the plane is still unknown. On March 8, 2014, the plane that departed from Kuala Lumpur, the capital of Malaysia, to go to Beijing, the capital of China, disappeared 40 minutes after taking off. Despite the most expensive underwater survey in history, it has not been determined why the plane carrying 239 people changed direction and flew south of the Indian Ocean and what happened to the plane afterwards. The authorities have not even approached the result at the end of 5 years in the incident, which has turned into one of the greatest mysteries of aviation history.

New mystery metal monolith appears on a California mountaintop

A new mystery metal monolith has appeared atop a mountain in California, just a week after a similar structure captured the imagination

of the world when it was discovered in the deserts of Utah – before being taken down and disappeared. The local newspaper in the small town of Atascadero, on the central California coast, reported that the silvery column had been found atop Pine mountain where dozens of local hikers made the trip to view it – and post their pictures on the internet. "The three-sided obelisk appeared to be made of stainless steel, 10-feet tall and 18 inches wide. The object was welded together at each corner, with rivets attaching the side panels to a likely steel frame inside," the Atascadero News reported.

Winter solstice: Jupiter and Saturn 'merge' in rare celestial event

A very rare, once-in-a-lifetime celestial event will shine brightly in the sky on Monday evening (21.12.2020) - as long as the weather allows, of course. Our two largest planets - Jupiter and Saturn - will appear to converge in what is called merging., The Winter Solstice. This will be where the planets will be closest since 1623, but at that time they were very close to the sun, making it very difficult to see the conjunction. If you are lucky enough to have a clear sky, you can see the event with the naked eye until 5pm GMT. According to Astronomy Ireland, it is important to find a place that is not very bright and has a clear view of the horizon. "The two planets don't actually get it. It's brighter, but the combination of the two will make them slightly brighter in the sky." Next time we have such a chance on August 24, 2414.

DO YOU KNOW PERCY JACKSON SERIES WRITER RICK RIORDAN?


Richard Russell Riordan Jr. better known as Rick Riordan is The New York Times bestselling American author of the Percy Jackson and Olympians series. Born on June 5, 1964, Rick Riordan grew up in Texas.




He attended the Alamo Heights High School, graduating in 1982. For higher education Rick enrolled at the University of Texas in Austin double majoring in English and history. After graduation from the university in 1986, Rick Riordan chose teaching for a career. For 15 years Rick taught English, history and Greek mythology at various middle schools in the San Francisco Bay Area and in San Antonio. In 2002, he was presented the St. Mary's Hall's first Master Teacher Award for his exceptional teaching services.

Rick began to enjoy writing from an early age. He made many unsuccessful attempts of publishing his short stories in teenage years. At school, Rick was appointed the editor of the high school newspaper. It was not until graduation from college and teaching in San Francisco that Riordan took writing seriously.

Riordan's son, Haley who was diagnosed with ADHD and dyslexia held a keen interest in a subject his father taught, Greek mythology. Then in the second grade, Haley would often request upon Rick to tell him stories inspired by Greek mythologies. In order to fulfill his son's request, Riordan quickly invented the character of Percy Jackson, a twelve year boy who suddenly discovers he is the son of



a Greek God. Riordan began a creatively crafted imaginative tale of Percy's expedition to bring back Zeus's lightning bolt in present day America. After Rick finished telling the story in three nights, Haley requested him to write down the story as a book. Not wanting to disappoint his son, Riordan took out time to write down the story. To show his respect and care for dyslexic children, Riordan attributed some characteristics of this



disease to Percy. Thus, Riordan's world famous Percy Jackson series came into being.

While living in California was enjoyable and comfortable for his wife and kids, Riordan yearned for Texas. His nostalgic feelings for Texas led him to write a mystery novel set in San Antonio, his hometown. The novel entitled Big Red Tequila featured the central character of Tres Nvarre, a private eye Ph.D in English. The novel received enthusiastic reviews and won Riordan the three most prestigious awards in the mystery genre.





The Lightning Thief






Percy's life hell. Whether being the son of a Greek god is an honor or a scourge, it will be revealed in this book.






